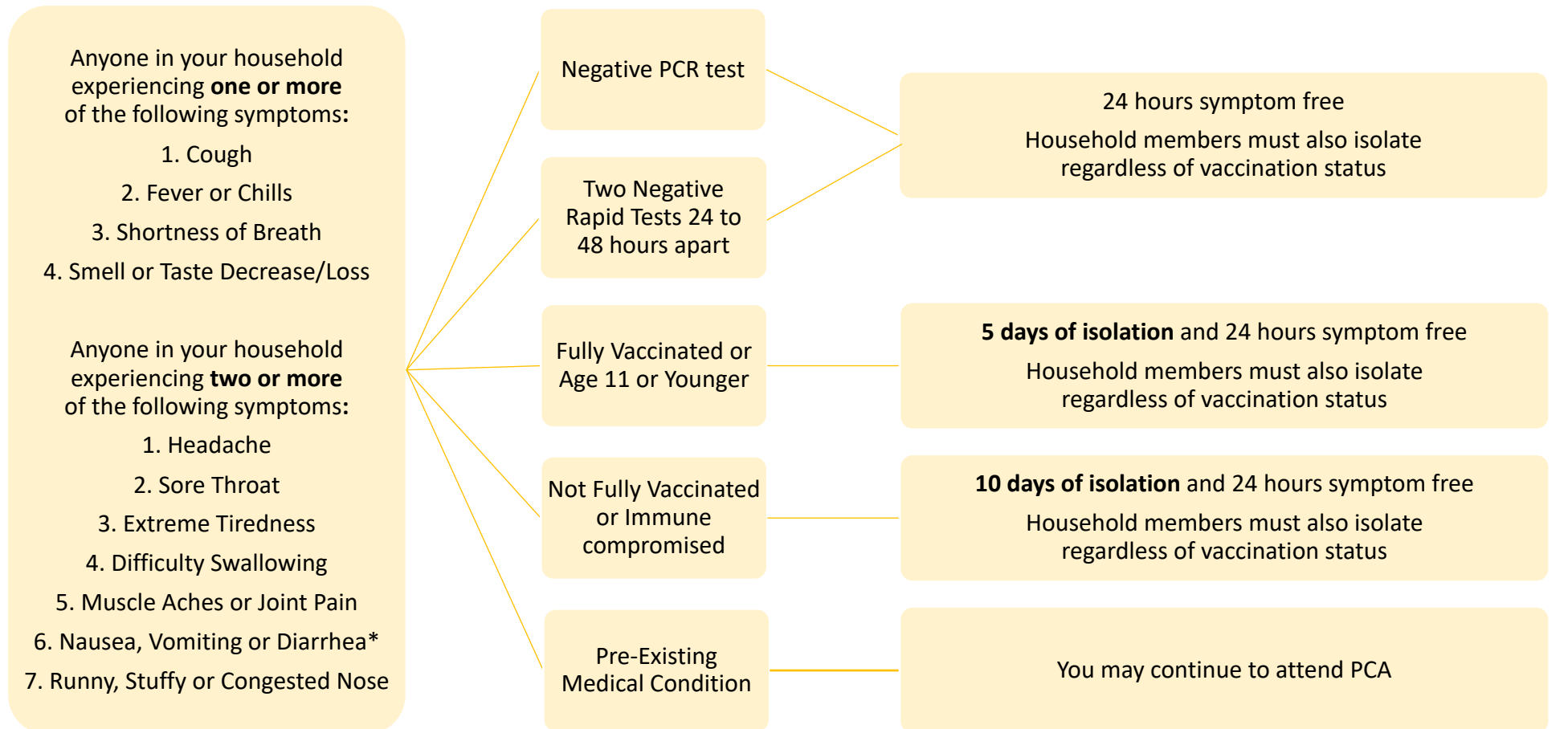


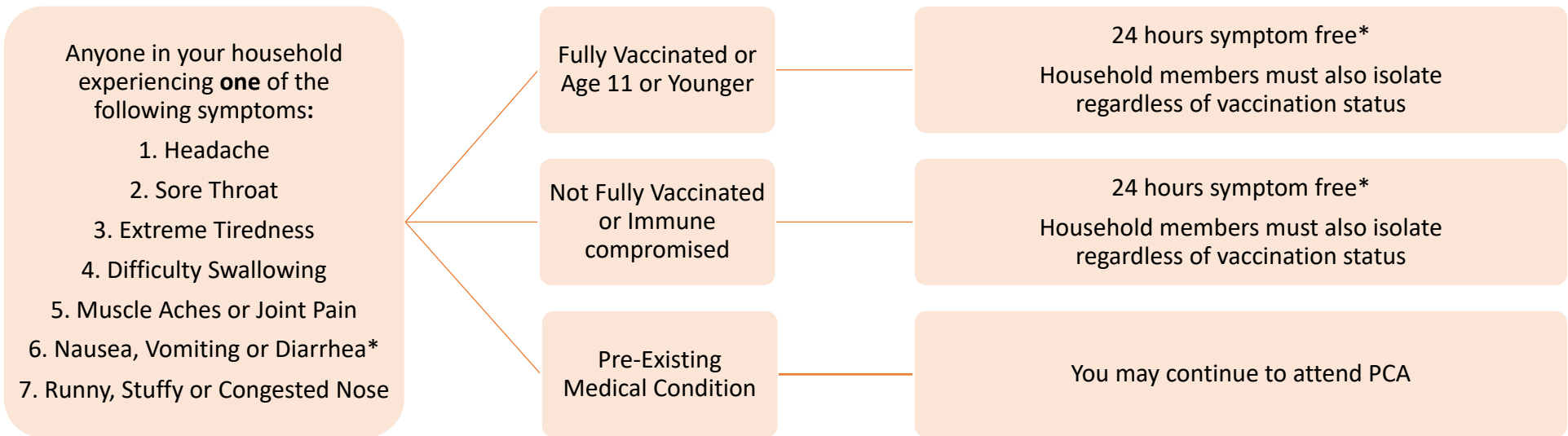
PCA COVID-19 PROTOCOL



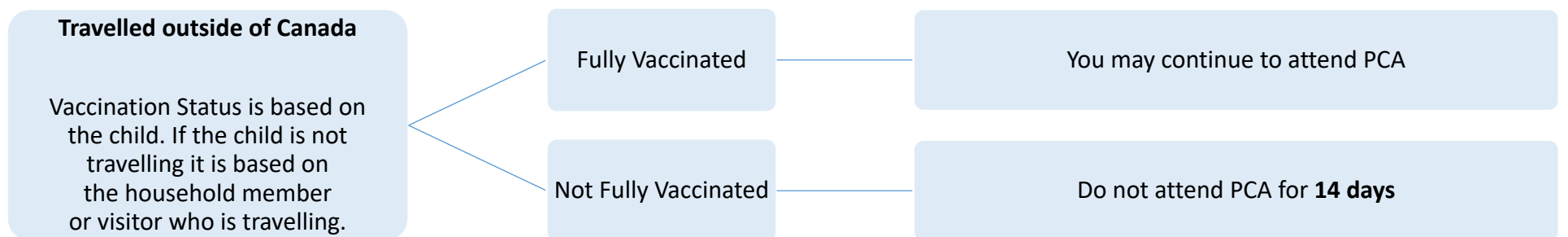
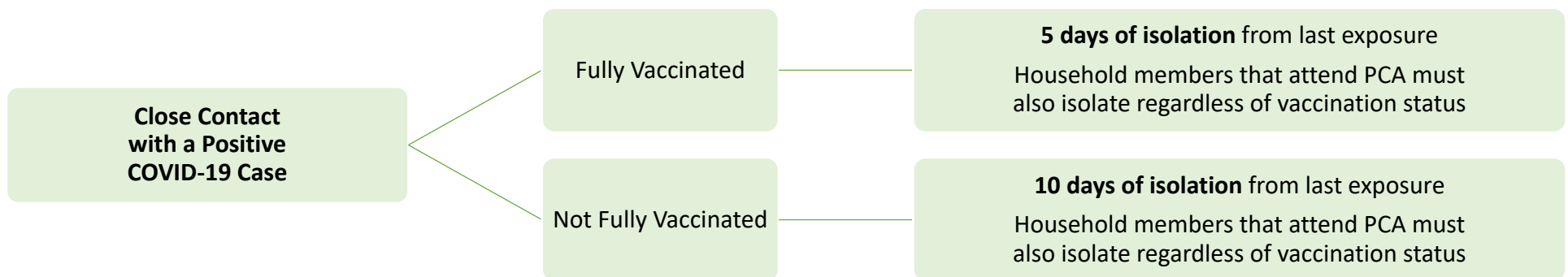
*48 hours symptom improvement for nausea, vomiting or diarrhea

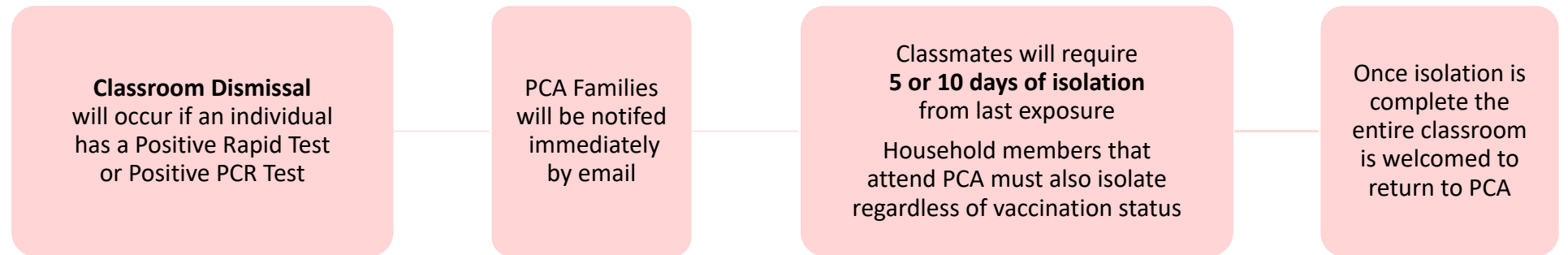
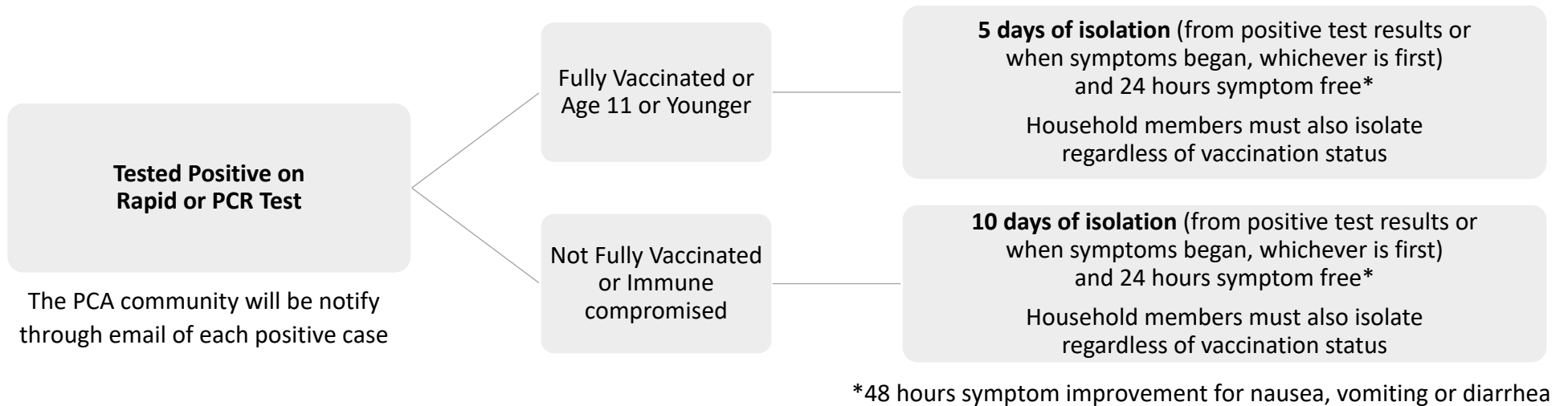
WHAT IF I FALL INTO ONE OF THESE CATEGORIES?

1. Keep your child at home as well as any household members that attend PCA, regardless of their vaccination status
2. Submit the PCA Absence Form at <https://forms.gle/NEzjwCv7sgXufYPb8> which will be sent to the office, PHCO and teacher
 - Please include the symptoms, the date symptoms began, date of close contact, travel and return date and/or date tested positive
3. The teacher will provide the online link and PHCO will provide further guidance

Close Contact: within 2 metres distance of a COVID-19 positive individual for at least 15 minutes or for multiple short periods of time without appropriate measures as masking and use of personal protective equipment

Fully Vaccinated: 14 days or more after an individual has received their second dose of two-dose COVID-19 vaccine series or their first dose of a one-dose COVID-19 vaccine series that is listed for emergency use by the World Health Organization or approved by Health Canada

Not Fully Vaccinated: Individuals who has not received both doses of a two-dose COVID-19 vaccine series that is listed for emergency use by the World Health Organization or approved by Health Canada; OR an individual who has received their full COVID-19 vaccine series but less than 14 days has passed since the date of last vaccination
